• **ACHIEVEMENTS**

CBSE Board Exam results of academic year were exceptional, with a 100% pass. Class X saw 74 distinctions and 39 first-class results, while Class XII had 45 distinctions and 34 first-class achievers, making us incredibly proud.

• **NEET AND JEE INITIATIVE**

To enhance our students' preparation for NEET and JEE MAINS, we have introduced training programs to enhance our students' preparation for these prestigious entrance exams in collaboration with RK Academy.

Furthermore, our KG and primary teachers actively participated in a professional development workshop organized at Maharishi Vidya Mandir Senior Secondary School, Chetpet, enriching their pedagogical expertise.

• **SPORTS**
