- We are very happy to announce that we had received the CBSE Provisional affiliation up to the Secondary Level Starting from 01 April 2019.
- Our School had received wide recognition for the best Teaching practices, awarded by the **zamit international** at the national level function organised at New Delhi.
- We started the Second academic year in the new premises on 8th April 2019.
- The school follows the CBSE curriculum and gets an academic support from MVM Chetpet, regarding framing of the syllabus up to conducting of examinations. Monthly inspection is done by the senior MVM staff to ensure due diligence.
- School election was conducted for school leaders on 11th June 2019, investiture

ceremony was held on 14th June 2019 and students were given portfolios.

- Students went on a rally to create awareness on
- **“Water conservation”** on streets of Choolai with placards & slogans on the dire need of saving water. Art & craft competitions were also conducted as instructed by the CBSE and State Government.

- Our Sports day was Conducted at Nehru Stadium, on September 5th with **Dr.P.Saminathan I.P.S** as our chief guest. In Sub Junior Category Aswin of class VII A4 & Aditi.S of class VI A2 won the individual championship. In Senior category Sanjith of class IX A1 & Vidyavarshini of IX A1 won the individual championship.
