- Lunch under the tree with nature outside the classroom from classes I to XII along with the class teachers was truly enjoyable by the students and shall be continued every year.
- Water bell is given at 11.a.m. and at 1.30 p.m. every day insisting students to drink water and to keep them hydrated.
